BRAMLEY ROAD

The Bramley name is that of Bramley, Surrey, and not that of Bramley in Yorkshire. The 1897 OS map shows some buildings, particularly on the south side, but by the 1901 census many more had been built. The rest were built before the 1911 census. Joshua Wilford and Sons were responsible for many of these and he often used names connected with his wife's birth on the Isle of Wight.
