

## WEST SIDE

Waghorn Road seems to have been planned during the 1870s, perhaps as part of a wider scheme taking in Queens Road and Queens Avenue. Before that it was occupied by the farmer of Covey Hall farm, who owned farm buildings and also one or two houses for his labourers at the High Street end. Access to his land was also from the High Street. The Hook family owned the Delamere estate to the east, so may have been active in the planning. By 1867 Matthew Tong, a blacksmith, had arrived and his forge behind Mulberry Cottage appears on the 1867 OS map – presumably he had the permission of the Hook family for it. When they wished to build the Devonshire Rooms and Almshouses, they seem to have provided him with a forge on the west side (replaced by the fire station (now the museum) in 1923, The first group of houses appeared as what are now numbers 5-19 and are listed in the 1881 census.
